Online High School

Toronto eSchool offers students the opportunity to earn Ontario High School credits online using a combination of online video instruction, online assessments and evaluations, regular personal teacher-student support, and a variety of opportunities for student-student interactions. Our school seeks to maximize the flexibility of our students' learning using the most modern and effective learning technology and resources available, while carefully ensuring that all the expectations and policies of the Ontario Ministry of Education are completely met.

Students can move through the material at their own pace. Our Ontario Certified Teachers guide students through the curriculum using well designed and professionally presented online instructional videos and multimedia resources. Our teachers provide valuable feedback through assignments, regular weekly online conferencing sessions, discussion forums, and direct email. Ontario Secondary School Diploma OSSD

OSSD Requirements

- Earn at least 30 Credits which includes 18 compulsory and 12 elective credits
- Complete 40 hours of community involvement activities
- · Complete the provincial literary requirement

To complete the provincial literary requirement for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma, a student must achieve a passing mark on the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT). The OSSLT is written in the spring (late March or early April) each year.

The following course selections are suggested for students who are aiming to be accepted into a specific university program. University admission is based on a student's average mark for six Gr. 12 University - level (U or M) courses. Marks for Gr. 12 courses required to meet university application requirements will be included in this average mark, as well as the student's other highest course marks.

Visa students already living and studying in Canada will be granted local student rates if proof of Canadian residency can be provided.

Report Cards and Grades

Students receive a midterm report when approximately 50% of the course material has been completed. A final report card is offered when all the assignments, unit test and final exam have been finished. A credit is granted for every course in which the student's grade is 50% or higher. 70% of the grade will be based on evaluations conducted throughout the course. 30% of the grade will be based on a final evaluation.

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

TES will issue the OSSD to students who take all of their courses with TES. TES will also issue the OSSD to students who have completed courses at other schools but took their final credit or credits with TES. The OSSD issued by TES is the same OSSD as issued by all other schools in Ontario and is fully recognized and accepted for entrance into all Canadian, U.K. and international universities.

OUAC/OCAS Services

TES will provide full—time students with assistance with the university/college application process and will forward the OST of full—time Grade 12 students applying to Ontario Universities' Application Centre and/or Ontario College Application Service. TES will also forward marks to OUAC and/or OCAS of any Grade 12 students who complete credit courses during the application process.



International High School Students



Application Procedure



N+1/ N+6 International Programs

Students earn the Ontario Secondary School Diploma with our online credits and equivalent credits from their high school in their home country. The N+1/N+6 program is divided into two phases of study.

Phase 1: Part-Time Study in Home Country (N Years)

Students take 3 to 4 online credit courses each year together with tutoring classes provided by a local teacher. Students have the flexibility to work on these credit courses around their own schedules, including evenings, weekends, and holidays (summer or winter), without affecting their regular high school study.

Phase 2: Full-Time Study in Canada (1 Year or 6 Months)

Phase 2 is completed during Grade 12 at the Toronto eSchool campus in Canada. During this time, students will complete the remainder of their OSSD Diploma requirements:

- · Earn remaining credit courses
- · Complete community service hours
- · Pass the OSSLT test (or complete OLC40 course if the student is unsuccessful on the test)

Our caring staff will assist international students in their adjustment to Canadian culture, lifestyle and the education system and make this transition as smooth as possible.


